- 1863—Youville Home (St. Albert) founded by the Sisters of Charity (Grey Nuns) of Montreal
- 1895—Edmonton General Hospital founded by the Sisters of Charity (Grey Nuns) of Montreal
- 1900—Misericordia Hospital founded by the Misericordia Sisters
- 1909—St. Mary's Hospital (Trochu) founded by the Sisters of Charity of Notre Dame d'Evron
- 1910—St. Joseph's General Hospital (Vegreville) founded by the Sisters of Charity of Notre Dame d'Evron
- 1911—Our Lady of the Rosary Hospital (Castor) founded by the Daughters of Wisdom
- 1919—St. Louis Hospital (Bonnyville) founded by the Sisters of Charity of Notre Dame d'Evron
- 1924—St. Mary's Hospital (Camrose) founded by the Sisters of Providence of St. Vincent de Paul
- 1927—St. Joseph's Auxiliary Hospital (Edmonton) founded by the Sisters of Providence of St. Vincent de Paul (Kingston)
- 1929—Mary Immaculate Hospital (Mundare) founded by the Sister Servants of Mary Immaculate
- 1929—St. Michael's General Hospital (Lethbridge) founded by the Sisters of St. Martha of Antigonish
- 1930—Banff Mineral Springs Hospital founded by the Sisters of St. Martha of Antigonish
- 1930—Killam General Hospital founded by the Sisters of St. Joseph of London
- 1976—Alberta Catholic Health Foundation (later changed to Alberta Catholic Health Corporation, ACHC) created in response to the Misericordia Sisters leaving the Misericordia Hospital
- 1986—The St. Louis Hospital is amalgamated with the Duclos Hospital and becomes the Bonnyville Health Centre
- 1988—Grey Nuns Hospital founded by Sisters of Charity (Grey Nuns) of Montreal, acute care services moved from the Edmonton General Hospital (now Edmonton General Continuing Care Centre)
- 1992—Caritas Health Group established with the consolidation of the Grey Nuns, Edmonton General and the Misericordia sites
- 2000—St. Michael's Health Centre opens, replacing the old St. Michael's Hospital
- 2002—St. Michael's Housing Association established
- 2005—Martha's House opens in Lethbridge
- 2005—Mary Immaculate Hospital under ACHC umbrella—last transfer of sponsorship to ACHC
- 2008—St. Therese Villa is opened by St. Michael's Lethbridge
- 2008—Youville Home becomes part of Caritas Health Group
- 2008—Covenant Health is established with the consolidation of the 16 sites under the governance of the ACHC
