St. Joseph's Home was opened in 1951 by the Carmelite Sisters of the Divine Heart of Jesus, who wanted to provide a comfortable home for seniors in the area. The Sisters cared for seniors for over 60 years until they retired.

The staff at St. Joseph's Home carry forward the Carmelite Sisters' commitment to loving and active service in many ways, one of which is Carmel Hospice. Opened in 2012 and named after the Carmelite Sisters, the hospice provides palliative care for the Medicine Hat community and embodies the Sisters' legacy of compassionate care.

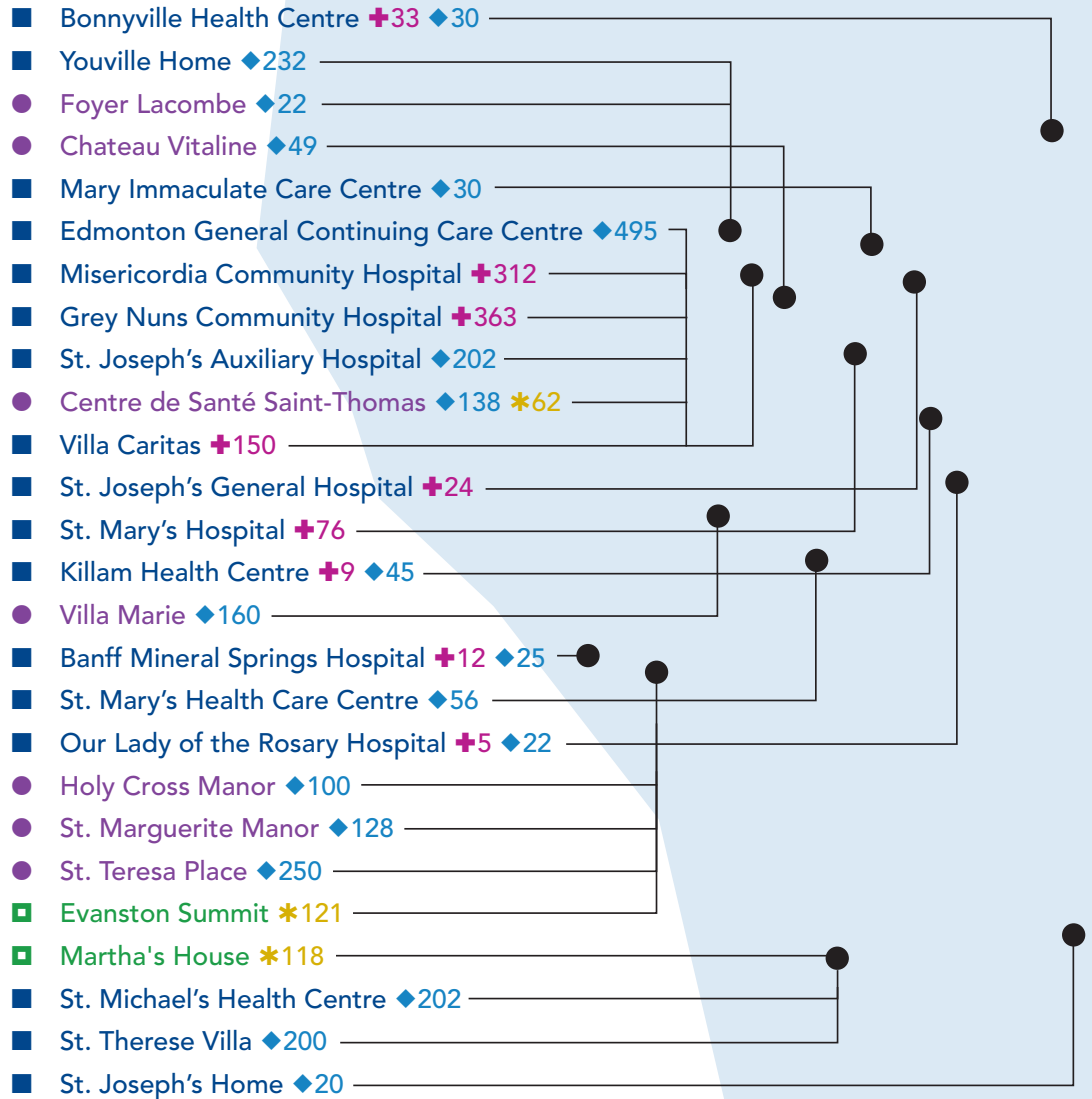
