Banff Mineral Springs Hospital was founded by the Sisters of St. Martha of Antigonish in 1930, and became part of the Covenant family on October 7, 2008.

Today, the hospital keeps the Sisters' legacy alive by providing compassionate care with the same determination and creativity. In 2002, the continuing care unit at Banff Mineral Springs was named St. Martha's Place in honour of its founding Sisters. Upholding quality of life for the 25 residents who call the unit home is of paramount importance to staff.

Banff Mineral Springs Hospital provides quality, responsive medical services, including emergency, EMS, specialized orthopedic and plastic surgery, continuing care and primary care to the local community and visitors from around the world.


