



Grey Nuns Community Hospital, Edmonton

The Grey Nuns' mission to be vibrant and compassionate signs of hope was seen first-hand by Edmonton when they founded the Edmonton General Hospital in 1895.

When the acute care services of the Edmonton General were transferred to the new Grey Nuns Community Hospital in 1988, staff walked from the Edmonton General to the Grey Nuns Hospital carrying a torch. This was symbolic of how they would carry forward the Sisters legacy of compassionate care at the new facility.

The Sisters were instrumental in establishing palliative care, mental health programs and care for pregnant mothers and babies as main focuses for the hospital. It provides a full range of health services to a diverse community in southeast Edmonton, following a deep-rooted tradition of healing the body, enriching the mind and nurturing the soul.

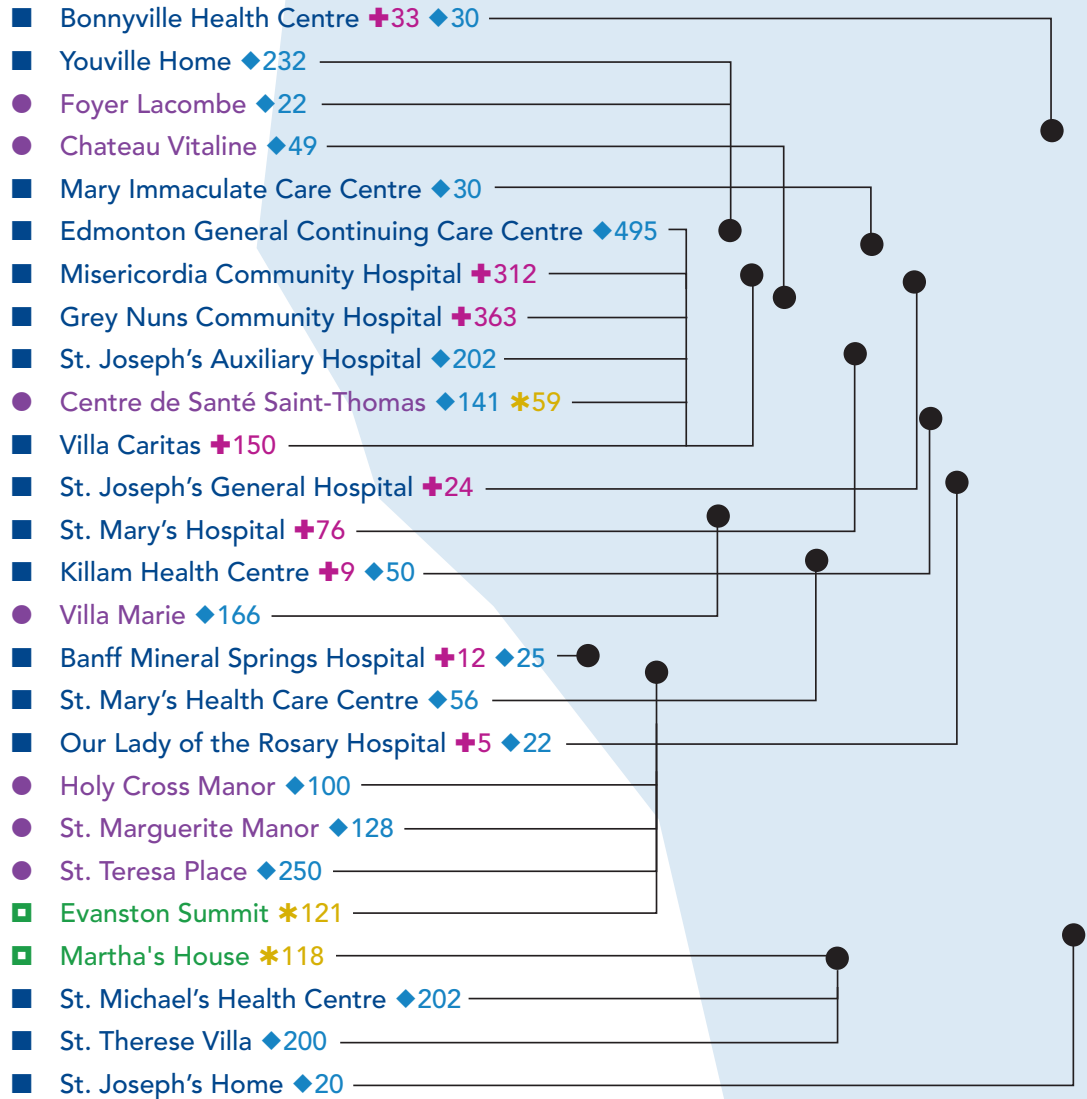
